

## **LEGAL NOTICE**

**If you dined at any of the following restaurants in Branson, Missouri, a class action Settlement may affect your rights:**

- Plantation
- Peppercorn
- Baldknobbers
- Fall Creek Steak and Catfish House
- Great American Steak and Chicken House
- Whipper Snappers

You may be affected if you dined at one of Fogle Enterprises, Inc. (“Fogle”)’s Restaurants, between February 28, 2009 and February 28, 2014 and paid a Community Development Fund, CDF, or similarly identified or described fee (“CDF Fee”) along with the cost of your meal. The lawsuit is called *Richard McMillin v. Fogle Enterprises, Inc. et al.*; Case No. 14AF-CC00154-01. The Parties have reached a proposed settlement on behalf of a “Class,” that could include you.

### **WHAT IS THIS CASE ABOUT?**

Fogle denies all the allegations in the lawsuit but the parties have reached a proposed settlement to avoid further litigation expenses. In the lawsuit, the Plaintiffs say Fogle unlawfully charged class members an additional 1-1.5% of their meal by including a CDF Fee on each transaction. Plaintiffs also allege that, to the extent Fogle provided any notice to its customers of the CDF Fee, the notice misrepresented how Fogle spent the monies collected by way of the CDF Fee.

### **WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND OPTIONS?**

- (1) You can remain in the Settlement Class and submit a “Claim Form” to obtain a settlement payment. To obtain a Claim Form, visit the settlement website: [www.FogleSettlement.com](http://www.FogleSettlement.com).
- (2) You can do nothing and you will not obtain a settlement payment.
- (3) You can “exclude” yourself from the Class.
- (4) You can “object” to the settlement by submitting an “Objection.”
